Mine camp attendants course

Mining and energy resource companies are eagerly searching for staff to fill positions as camp attendants and camp housekeepers.

Southern Queensland Institute of TAFE (SQIT) is offering a new course to meet this demand.

The Camp Housekeeping and Food Safety Introduction Course provides students with the skills to work in a mining or resources workers' camp.

The course focuses on food safety and housekeeping and runs over four days, topics covered include food safety procedures, housekeeping services and room preparation.
