2015 SOUTH BURNETT BUSINESS EXCELLENCE AWARDS

Bill Hull Car Centre Micro Business Award

A micro-business is a business with less than five (5) employees, and includes self-employed individuals. They are important to the economy as they provide employment to a large portion of the workforce, facilitate innovation and entrepreneurship, as well as provide an avenue for offering specialised and niche products and services to the market. This award recognises business excellence and acumen for any business with between 1 and 5 staff members (FTE's). Eligible businesses can be from any industry or sector.

Burnett Business Centre Small Business Award

Small businesses complement the economic activity of large organisations by providing them with goods and services, and make up the backbone of the supply chains of larger projects. They power regional development and are the gateway through which many people enter the economy. This award acknowledges a South Burnett business operated and managed to facilitate sustainability and success with between 6 and 20 staff (FTE's).

Supa IGA Kingaroy Enterprise Award

For the purposes of these awards, an Enterprise is any business with more than 20 staff. Small to Medium Enterprises are said to be responsible for driving innovation and competition in many economic sectors. Eligibility for this category is more than 20 employees (FTE's); businesses can be from any industry or sector.

Tarong Power Stations Young Business Leader Award

This award recognises a business whose owner or manager demonstrates leadership qualities and business skills and is aged 30 years or younger as at 30 June 2015.

Proteco Emerging Business Award

This award acknowledges excellence and innovation in businesses that have been operating in the South Burnett region for no longer than two (2) years. To be eligible for this category, your business must have commenced operation after 1 July 2013.

The following award categories are included in the 2015 schedule, but are not available for nomination as part of this nomination kit; nominees have been / will be selected through a different process.

Meandu Mine People's Choice Customer Service Award

This is for community members to recognise and say thanks to those businesses that go above and beyond. Nomination forms will be available at multiple locations across the region for customers to nominate a business delivering continued exceptional customer service.

Swickers Distinguished Business Service Award

This a special category awarded by the judging panel. They will consider any South Burnett business contributor, past or present, and merit the award on business success and achievement as well as contribution to the South Burnett business community.

Local Business Association Award

Each Business Association Group nominates one of their local businesses for this category.

Heritage Business of the Year Award

The Business of the Year will be selected from the winners of the Micro Business Award, Small Business Award, Enterprise Award, Young Business Leader Award, and the Emerging Business Award.

The judging will be assessed on the written submission only. Please take care to include all relevant information to address the criteria questions.

Judges are required to select up to five (5) finalists in each category (depending on the number of nominations received) and one (1) category winner. The overall Business of the Year Award winner will be selected from the winners of the Micro Business Award, Small Business Award, Enterprise Award, Young Business Leader Awards, and Emerging Business Award.
