## SAFETY TIPS

- Never leave your bicycle unattended and unlocked, even for a short time (it only takes seconds to steal a bicycle).
- Secure your bicycle with a quality bike lock to something solid (ensure that the bicycle cannot be lifted off).
- If it is easy to remove, take off your front wheel and secure it to the rear wheel.
- Remove accessories from the bicycle, such as lights, pumps and your helmet.
- Use a security device that is not easily cut or removed.
