Contest Rules:

All work submitted must combine a digital component with any mix of other media – eg digital design with acrylic paint.

Artists must be between 12 to 24 years of age on 1st June 2013. Artists must have a strong personal link to the South Burnett Region, including students living and studying in the region, students with parents or guardians living in the region, and former students or residents of the South Burnett who are now working or studying outside the region.

Entrants agree that if their work is the winner of the Acquisitive Youth Art Competition 2013, and on payment of the award, the said work shall become the property of the South Burnett Regional Council.

Artwork must not be greater than 1 metre square when framed (a stretched canvas is considered framed). All artwork must be dry and ready for display, with 'D' rings securely attached 8 to 10 cm from the top for larger work, and 5 cm for small work.

Entry Forms should be returned to the Kingaroy Regional Art Gallery, 128 Haly Street, Kingaroy by 4pm Saturday 18th May, and Artwork **MUST** be delivered to the Gallery no later than 4 pm, Saturday 1st June, 2013.

Entries will be exhibited in the Kingaroy Regional Art Gallery during the month of June (subject to the Gallery's discretion) with winners announced during the Exhibition Opening on Saturday, 8th June. Winners will be notified in advance so they can be present on the day.

Sale of Work (Commission and Payment)

A Gallery Commission of 20% applies to all works sold during the exhibition unless 'NFS' is entered on the Entry Form in the space provided. The work's price as listed on the entry form should include the Gallery Commission of 20% plus GST (if applicable).

Work sold will be released to the purchaser at the end of the Exhibition and after full payment has been received by the Gallery. Unsold work entered in the competition will be released at the end of the exhibition.

The Gallery will exercise all reasonable care of all artwork from time of receipt to the end of the collection period, however the artist, and/or the artist's agent agrees to indemnify the South Burnett Regional Council, Kingaroy Regional Art Gallery, and staff, against loss or damage to their artwork during this period.

Artists agree that their work may be photographed by the South Burnett Regional Council and published in relation to the exhibition, for marketing, educational, and review purposes.
